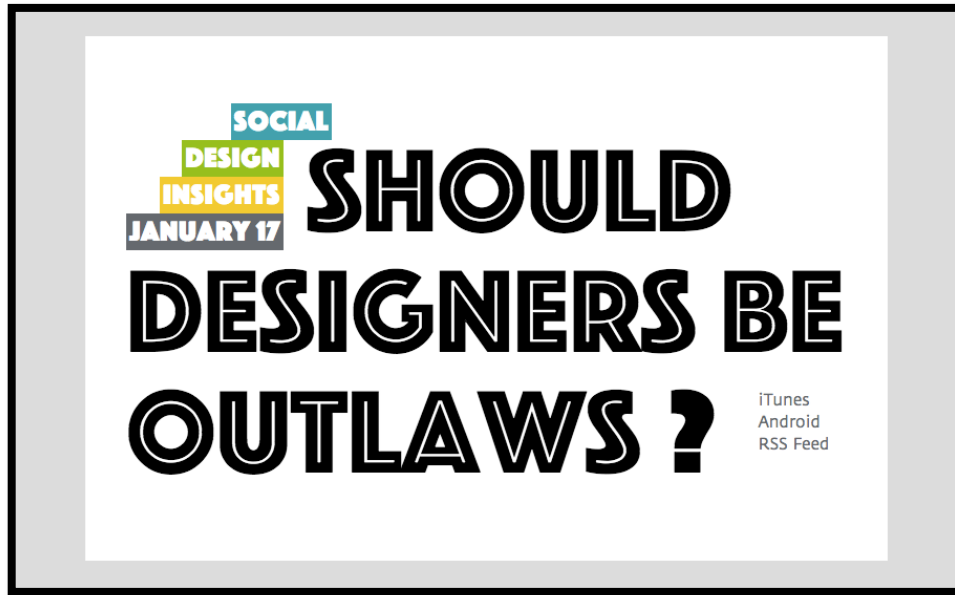

## Curry Stone Design Prize Launches 'Social Design Insights' Podcast
